VENUE

The 4-star Barcelo Valencia is a stylish, modern hotel located in the heart of Valencia, Spain, directly opposite the iconic City of Arts and Sciences. It features 187 bright, contemporary rooms, a tenth-floor terrace with city views, a seasonal rooftop pool, a Mediterranean restaurant, and a wellness area with a sauna and steam bath (pool and wellness area open seasonally at the discretion of the hotel)



TRAVEL

- **Metro** (Most Cost-Effective): Take Line 5 from the airport station to Amistat station. The journey is approximately 20-25 minutes. The hotel is about a 15-minute walk (1.2 km) from the station, or you can catch a short taxi from the stand near the hospital.
- **Taxi** (Fastest & Easiest): Taxis are readily available at the airport. The journey takes about 15-20 minutes depending on traffic and costs roughly €20-€30.
- **Ride-Sharing** (Uber/Cabify): You can also book a private car via apps, which can be found at the airport



ARRIVAL & ACCESSIBILITY

The main reception at the hotel is on different levels. Do ask to be directed to the 'Registration Desk' for this meeting. Lifts are available if you do not want to use the stairs. Do make it known when you register if you would prefer to be seated at the front of the room if this helps with visibility, hearing etc. Wifi will be available and we will provide you with details of this on the day.

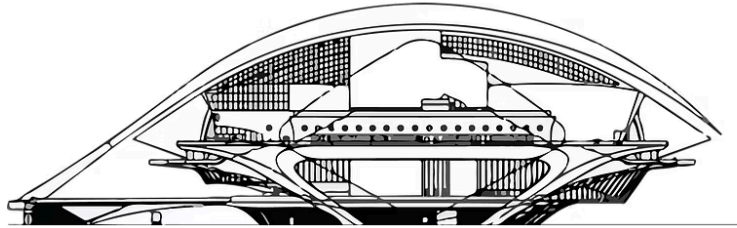
LANGUAGE
